

AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

KAYE ACADEMIC COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, ISRAEL

and

In this present agreement the partnership and cooperation between these two institutions is declared.

1. The subject of the Agreement is collaboration in the areas of scientific research and professional development, representing mutual interest for both parties.
2. Within the framework of the regulations applying in each institution, and subject to the availability of resources, the following programs and activities will be encouraged:
 - 2.1. The exchange of scientific information, educational literature, textbooks, curriculums and joint publications, which are issued by both parties.
 - 2.2. The discussion of research results at possibly online joint meetings, seminars, conferences, scientific consultations.
 - 2.3. The joint publications in professional scholarly journals in English.
 - 2.4. The possibility of exchange of professors, scientific associates and students with the aim of realization of collaborative research projects, conduction of or participation in lectures, workshops and seminars at the hosting institution.
 - 2.4.1. Travel costs for faculty members will be covered by the traveling institution, the subsistence costs will be covered by the hosting institution.
 - 2.4.2. Travel costs and subsistence costs for students will be covered by the students themselves.

3. Other obligations:

- 3.1. Financial expenditures on realization of the given Agreement are carried by both parties within the limits of own financial possibilities. The parties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion and be the responsibility of the visitor's home institution.
- 3.2. The specific areas and details of cooperation within the framework of this agreement shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate authority of each university, prior to the initiation of any particular programme or activity.
- 3.3. The agreement shall become effective from the date of the last signature and remain in force for a period of five (5) years with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving six months notice to the other party in writing. It may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties, or amended by the exchange of letters.
